With the help of HHCC elves, Queen Ethelburga's Collegiate (QE), Volunteers, the HDFT Exec Team, Harrogate Railway Athletic F.C, HHCC supporters, HDFT and Harrogate Integrated Facilities (HIF) colleagues, we achieved this. Below is a snapshot of what happened:

- 1,000 + Gifts: working with QE on their gift appeal, we provided over 1,000 gifts to Children, Young People and Families across our 0-19 Children's Services
- 1,000 + Festive Hampers: the team and I sourced, packed and delivered over 1,000 Festive Hampers to families in need with the help of the Harrogate Railway Athletic F.C. First Team Squad and the HDFT Exec Team
- 1,000 + Miles Covered: Chief Elf Les (his day job being a porter with HIF), along with the HHCC elves, covered over 1,000 miles to deliver the gifts and Festive Hampers
- 1,800 Mince Pies: delivered to bring festive cheer to those who may be lonely or isolated

Your support and donations are used to raise vital funds for staff, patients and their families who work and access facilities across HDFT. You make huge positive differences.
