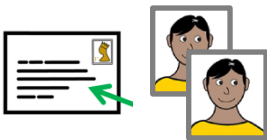


Identification Checks for Volunteer DBS



Before we can carry out a DBS check for you, you will need to provide 3 forms of valid identification.



This can be **2** types of identification with your photograph on it and **1** with your name and home address on it dated within the appropriate time frame.

You can bring **1** type of identification with your photograph on it and **2** with your name and home address on it dated within the appropriate time frame.

















If you do not have any photographic identification, then a UK birth certificate issued within **12** months of birth will be fine.

Documents may be scanned and emailed if you are unable to provide them in person but the originals must be verified on or before commencement.

Please see below some examples of items to bring:



- Current passport.
- UK photocard or paper driving licence.
- UK Birth certificate dated within **12** months of birth.

		<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Financial statement (e.g. pension, ISA) that is no older than 12 months.• Council tax or mortgage statement that is no older than 12 months.• P45/P60 that is no older than 12 months.• Benefits statement or any letter from a government office that is no older than 3 months.• Utility bill or bank statement that is no older than 3 months.
